

What follows is an alphabetical listing of employees in the ledger. Beginning with a ledger named "PETTY JOURNAL" starting in Aug 1892 and continuing till the end of 1894. I looked at one week's list then compared that list with the next weeks' list. Adding any names that were not in any previous list. So, the results of this should be a complete list of all the Coppes employees, even if they only were employed for a short time. Several men were only listed as employees one time, which should tell us that Coppes Bros. & Zook used temporary help quite often. Area men that wanted to earn cash maybe could get a temporary job at Coppes when they had the extra time. I added the job description when it is in the Ledger. Also, interesting are the listings with the line "per someone's name". For example, the line would read "Sept 10 - Stanffer & Defrees - Labor per P. Hunt - \$1.25". Did they allow people to work in place of someone else? In two listings the number of hours worked is recorded. One man worked 20 hours and was paid \$3.00 or \$.15 cents an hour, another man worked 59 hours one week and was paid \$7.37 or \$.12 1/2 cents per hour.
